Start Applying

Before beginning your application, be prepared with the following:

1. A current academic transcript (official or unofficial).
2. A résumé.
3. Two letters of recommendation, including one letter from an instructor, employer or industry professional.

Suggested examples of work based on program:

- For advertising, graphic design, or photography: submit three portfolio pieces
- For advertising or marketing: submit three examples of work representing advertising or marketing strategies
- For broadcast, film, music, performing arts or web/interactive: submit three URLs of work showcasing a portfolio piece, i.e. a YouTube or Vimeo link or a live website
- For web/interactive: submit work showing web design, UI or UX

All applications must be submitted by 5pm on Friday, February 16, 2018. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.

Scholarship winners will be notified of their status by Friday, February 28, 2018.

Tips when applying

Read and follow all directions. Do not wait until the last minute to get started, as it may require some time to complete the application and get the necessary letters of recommendation, copies of transcripts and examples of work together.

You need to submit only one application to be considered.
